

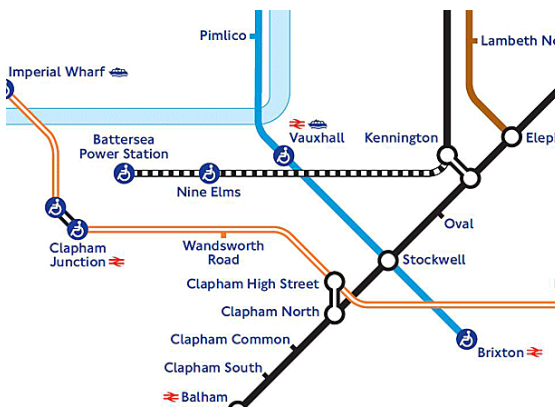

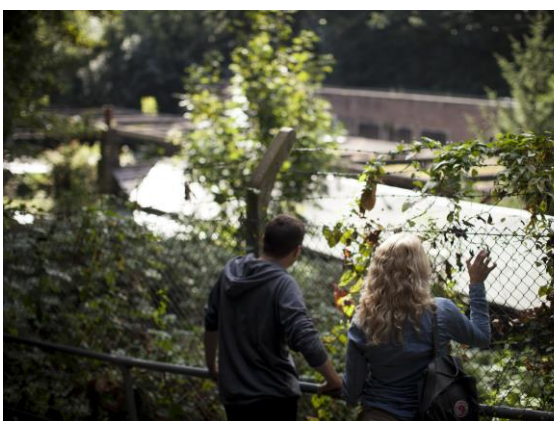
We will end the evening with drinks at the Perkin Reveller which overlooks the Thames in the historic Tower Wharf.
