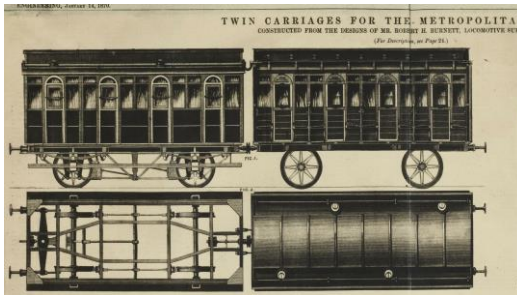
1938 stock: journey to Metro-land

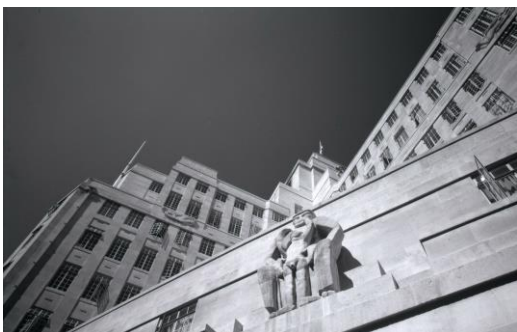
Elizabeth line: trial operations
