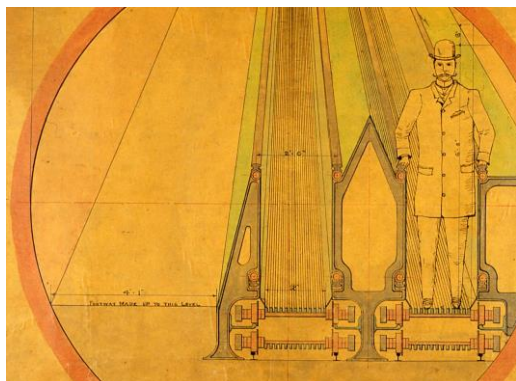
### Kingsway Tram Subway

We are opening the gates again to this pioneering Grade II listed structure. The Kingsway Tram Subway was the country's first tram tunnel and innovative for its time. Opened in 1906, the Subway operated for less than 50 years and provided the only north to south link on London's tram networks.

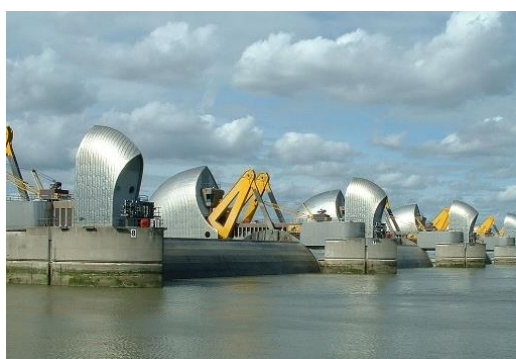
## Private guided tour of Kempton Steam Museum

Fellow Patron, Paul Ross, invites you to join him for a private guided tour of the world's largest triple-expansion steam pumping engine in action. Dating from 1926–1929, each engine at the Kempton Park Waterworks pumped 19 million gallons of water a day to supply north London with drinking water taken from the River Thames.



## Tour of the London Coliseum

## Tour of the Thames Barrier Information Centre and Thames Barrier Navigation Centre
